Christopher Goff is CEO & General Counsel of Employers Health Coalition of Ohio and its subsidiary, Employers Health Purchasing Corporation of Ohio. Employers Health is a coalition of employers in Ohio and eleven other states, representing over 2 million covered lives nationally. Employers Health is engaged in group purchasing, lobbying, healthcare quality initiatives, community health improvement and education. Prior to 1995, Mr. Goff held management positions in three managed health care organizations.

A consultant and counsel to plan sponsors in the area of employee benefits, Mr. Goff served on the Booz Allen Hamilton consulting team as an expert advisor to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for Part D pharmacy implementation activities resulting from the Medicare Modernization Act of 2003. He is on the faculty of the College for Advanced Management of Health Benefits, affiliated with Thomas Jefferson Medical College, Department of Health Policy, where he teaches the pharmacy benefits management track. He has served on the URAC PBM Accreditation and Employer Advisory Boards as well as the Pharmacy Benefits Management Institute Advisory Board and currently serves on the Ohio Department of Health's Hospital Measures Advisory Council. Mr. Goff also serves on Daiichi-Sankyo's Center for Health Care Consumerism Advisory Board and Astra Zeneca's US Payer Advisory Board. Additionally, he is a frequent advisor to several large pharmaceutical manufacturers regarding employer and PBM related topics.
